Supporting Commitment and Performance

The Whistler Nordic Development Centre (WNDC) is designed for Nordic athletes who want to advance on the high-performance pathway, leading to international podium success and personal leadership.

New in 2023/24, select WNDC Team athletes may be invited to participate in the WNDC Scholarship Program. After goal setting with the coaching team, athletes are then required to meet individual benchmarks throughout the program year 2023/24. Once all criteria are met, the athlete successfully completes the scholarship program and receives a reimbursement for their WNDC program fee.

Scholarship Eligibility & Details	
Scholarship Objective	To support WNDC athletes who demonstrate outstanding commitment and performance, by reimbursing the WNDC program fee after a successful completion of the program year 2023/24. To successfully complete the scholarship program, athletes have to meet individual criteria, including physical, technical and mental benchmarks, throughout the program year.
Candidate Selection	The WNDC coaching team evaluates WNDC team athletes and invites select team members to participate in the scholarship program. Selection is made based on the potential for exceptional commitment and performance.
Scholarship Timeline:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>April 1:</i> Applications close for WNDC program year 2023/24.• <i>Early April:</i> WND coaching team selects candidates for participation in the scholarship program and sends out invitations to those selected.• <i>May 1:</i> Start of WNDC program year 2023/24. As the scholarship is deemed completed at the end of the program year/April 2024, selected scholarship candidates will still pay the initial WNDC team fees, with the objective of receiving a fee reimbursement after successful program completion. Scholarship candidate and coaching team jointly agree on criteria for the fulfillment of the scholarship, including physical, technical and mental benchmarks.• <i>End of September:</i> First benchmark review to ensure athlete is on track in fulfilling the defined performance criteria in order to continue in the scholarship program. Assessment of general prep and goal setting for winter/race season. Are all criteria met, athlete may continue in the program and fees for the winter season are waived.• <i>End of March:</i> Race season assessment/review. If performance criteria set for winter/race season are met, athlete receives a full reimbursement of the previously paid fees.
