Volunteer Role

Title:	Volunteer Ambassador, Sport School
Reporting to:	Manager, Sport and Programming
Department:	Whistler Olympic Park

Overview

Volunteer Ambassador, Sport School, assists Nordic Sport Instructor to enhance the instructional experience of guests participating in Sport School programs which is an important component of our sport delivery initiatives at Whistler Olympic Park and to grow sport. This is a skiing role that requires a competent level of classic and skate skiing. This role assists instructors with lesson preparation and delivery, staging, rental equipment fitting and returns, group supervision, and instruction. This is a seasonal volunteer role with the majority of school programs occurring Monday to Friday, 10:00am to 2:00pm. Occasional evening/weekend and holiday program shifts may be available.

Volunteering is based on a minimum of 40 hours per season with a commitment of ten (10) four (4) hour shifts (10 x 4-hour shifts). Sign up is via the on-line schedule as directed and is subject to each team's schedule of open shifts (i.e., week-ends, week days, or evenings).

Responsibilities

- Attend all volunteer orientation sessions
- Under the direction of the Supervisor, Sport School and Manager, Sport and Programming, complete tasks with WOP staff, other professionals, and Volunteer Ambassadors
- Assist Nordic Sport Instructor to set up class equipment and assignment of rental equipment
- Support delivery of ski instructional sessions and multi-sport programs (camps, pro-d days)
- Prepare and monitor instructional and ski play areas to ensure safety and fun
- Light physical work; shoveling of ski play area, and setting up of instructional tools / games
- Knowledgeable about Whistler Sport Legacies, and respond effectively to snow sport inquiries
- Carry out Whistler Sport Legacies' customer service philosophy: AIM (all interactions matter)
- Assist team with other duties as requested
- Reliable winter transportation is needed as WOP is not serviced by transit

- RCMP Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector is required prior to first volunteer shift
